ABOUT THE ORGANIZER



Clean Cities Georgia (CC-GA) is a nonprofit coalition dedicated to advancing clean transportation adoption through stakeholder engagement, fleet conversions, grant matching, and outreach. Established in 1993 as the first Coalition founded under the U.S. Department of Energy's Clean Cities and Communities National Partnership, it serves as the central coordinator for alternative fuel vehicle (AFV) activities across Georgia.

The coalition collaborates with vehicle fleets, fuel providers, community leaders, and other stakeholders to identify and implement strategies that reduce petroleum consumption by matching the right alternative fuel to the right vehicle application. Through its initiatives, Clean Cities Georgia aims to increase domestic energy security, improve air quality, and support the transition to a more sustainable transportation sector within the state.
